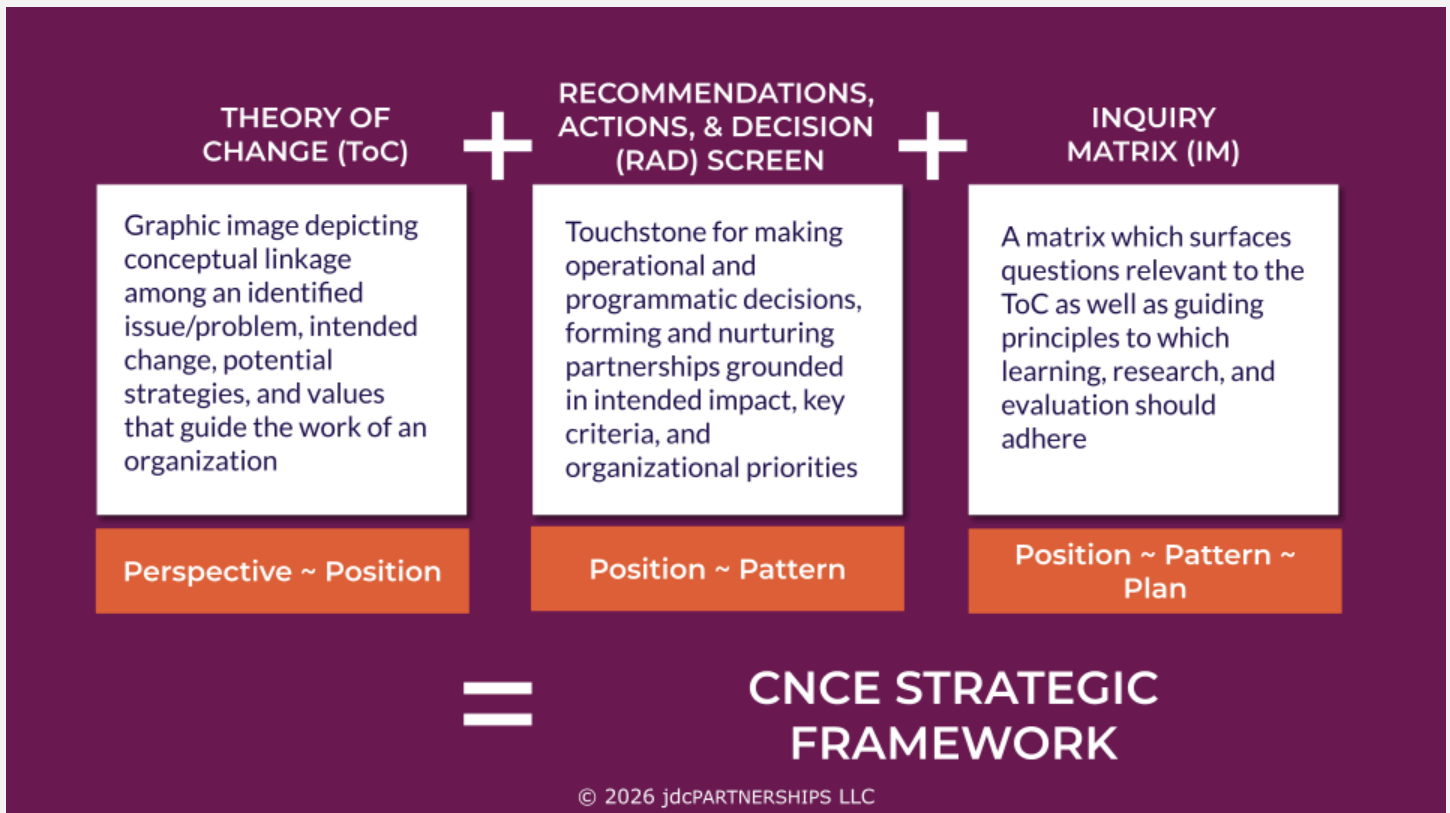
Why CNCE Matters

- **Clarity over certainty.** Plans are not reality. In uncertain times, this becomes abundantly evident. Clarity provides the grounding needed for adaptive and responsive action.
- **Learning as a strategic asset.** The Evaluative Inquiry model embeds curiosity, reflection, and sense-making into daily practice—strengthening organizational rigor and adaptability.
- **Perspective and Position.** Organizations articulate how they see the world (Perspective) and their unique contribution within it (Position).
- **Pattern and Plan.** Shared behaviors (Pattern) are aligned with adaptive, values-driven actions (Plan) recognizing conditions and capacity that remain relevant in shifting contexts.
- **The human element.** Strategy is dependent on the people whose beliefs, intentions and efforts are aligned, and they are equipped to act collectively.
